



FINA / ARENA SWIMMING WORLD CUP 2009 SINGAPORE 21 & 22 NOVEMBER 2009 3 WORLD RECORDS IN ONE DAY



The final day of the FINA ARENA World Cup in Singapore saw three new world marks set. The first went to South Africa's Kathryn Meaklim in the 400m individual medley, who touched home in 4min 22.88sec — nearly three seconds off the previous mark held by Spain's Mireia Belmonte — to capture the gold. Then it was the turn of the United States' Peter Marshall, who stormed home with a time of 22.61 in the 50m backstroke, breaking his own world mark of 22.73 set last week in Stockholm. Fittingly, in the final major race of 2009, Therese Alshammar of Sweden captured the women's 50m butterfly gold with a new world record of 24.38, lowering the previous mark of 24.99 held by Australia's Marieke Guehrer. **TODAYONLINE**
